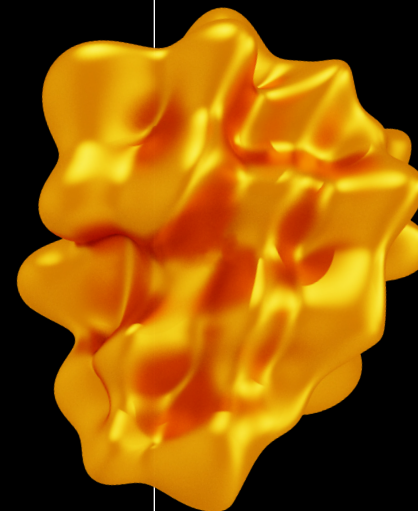
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Dear freshman,

TRANSPORT

During the study period, some lectures may take place outside your faculty, therefore, you will have to travel to the student campus or the faculties in the city centre. Buses or trolleybuses are a perfect choice for commuting. With a student identity card, a one-time ticket has a 50%discount, and the monthly ticket for students is with 80%discount.



BE MOBILE



Buses no. **37** and no. **40** from the [Faculty of Civil Engineering and Architecture](#) and the [Faculty of Chemical Technology](#) on the student campus can help you to reach the city centre. You can choose [Studentų St](#) or the [Zoo](#) stop, whichever is more convenient for you. When leaving the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Design, it is more convenient to choose the stops located on [Pašilės](#) or [Breslaujos](#) streets, from which buses no. **39** and no. **57G** run.

Buses no. **37** and no. **40** leave from the [Faculty of Social Sciences, Art and Humanities](#) and the [School of Economics and Business](#) to the [Faculty of Chemical Technology](#) or the [Faculty of Civil Engineering and Architecture](#), which go to the [Zoo](#) or [Studentų St](#) stops. The names of the nearest stops are [Studentų Square](#) or [Gedimino St](#), and if you need to go to the [Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Design](#), you can choose buses no. **39** and no. **57G** which will bring you to [Pašilės St](#) stop.

Trolleybuses **5**, **14** and **15** run from the student campus to the city centre. You can choose [Pašilės St](#) or [Breslaujos St](#) stop, whichever is more convenient for you. Trolleybuses **5**, **13** and **16** run from the [Faculty of Social Sciences, Art and Humanities](#) and the [School of Economics and Business](#) to KTU student campus. The nearest stops are [Studentų Square](#) or [Gedimino St](#).

In addition to trolleybuses and buses, the faculties can be reached by other transport, such as bicycles or scooters. You can leave your bicycles safely at the bicycle storage at the faculty entrances, and take your scooter with you to the classrooms, just park it so that it does not obstruct anyone's movement on the premises. If you do not have these vehicles – no problem! In certain places of Kaunas you can find where to rent them, the nearest location is near the faculty on [Studentų St](#). **50** or the [Zoo](#) bus stop.

ORGANISATION OF STUDIES

Study module

A study programme consists of the study modules taught for one semester. A study module may include various combinations of lectures, laboratory work, practice, seminars, the student's independent work, research, design work or another type of work. Study modules may be mandatory, alternative (selected from a list), general and optional (from the list of the modules offered by the University). The studies of each module are completed by an evaluation of the students' knowledge and skills – an examination or a different form of the final assessment. Find your timetable, assessment evaluation and other relevant information about studies in the [Academic Information System \(AIS\)](#).

Study credit

The scope of studies is measured in study credits defining a student's workload. The full-time study workload for one year is 60 credits – 1600 work hours.

Assessment system

In the University, the cumulative assessment method is used: study results are evaluated by intermediate assessments, and the final grade is the sum of the results of intermediate assessments and the final assessment. A student is allowed to participate in the final assessment only if all intermediate assessments are submitted.

Study programme

Studies at the University are carried out according to the study programmes leading to a bachelor's, master's or doctoral degree. The volume of the bachelor's study programme is 180 or 240 study credits, the master's study programme – 90 or 120 credits, integrated studies – 300 credits. After fulfilling all the requirements of the study programme, the student receives a bachelor's or master's degree, and a diploma and its supplement.

Quality of studies

The opinion of each student is important in the process of improving the quality of studies. Contribute to the improvement of the quality of studies:

- Give your opinion to the lecturers, the group elder (contact person) or the head of your study programme;
- Participate in online surveys using the opportunity to express the opinion in confidence.

Tuition fees

The students pay tuition fees if they:

- Study in a state non-funded position;
- Repeat individual modules of the study programme;
- Have selected additional modules not included in the study programme;
- Are retaking the intermediate and final assessment of the module for the second time;
- Fail to get the final assessment of the module and take it externally next semester.

Attendance

Students' participation in the academic classes of the modules is obligatory: in laboratory works – 100%, in practical classes – min. 80%, in theory classes – min. 60%. The instructor sets specific attendance requirements that are introduced to students during the first class of the module. The attendance requirements are provided in the description of each study module.

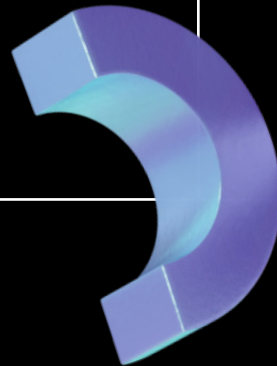

Distance studies and blended learning

The lectures, consultation seminars and practical classes can be organised remotely. However, if the study module's learning outcomes can only be achieved using the equipment located on the University's premises, the classes are on campus. The students are responsible for being equipped with the technical measures required for remote synchronous learning – a computer or another digital device, the internet connection, a video camera, a microphone, headphones, as well as the preparation of the place for distance learning.

If a student does not have the technical measures and cannot acquire them, he/she has to write to the University's Career and Service Centre via klausk@ktu.lt.

Students have to follow the [code of academic conduct](#) and the [main principles of students' ethics and behaviour during studies](#) during both – distance studies and studies on campus.

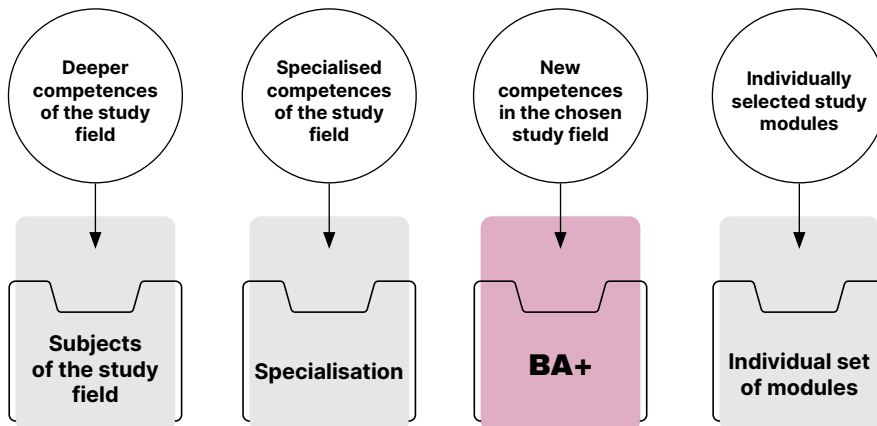

BA+ ALTERNATYVOS

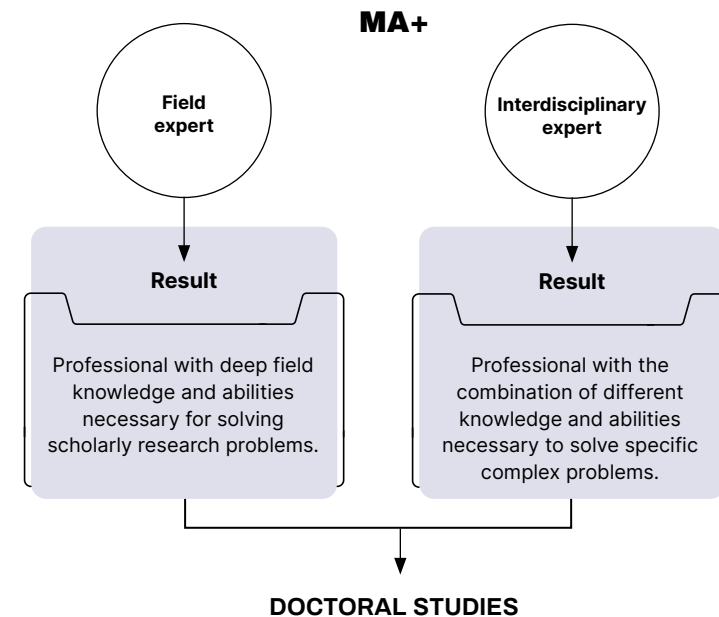

Master's studies at Kaunas University of Technology are the first such studies in Lithuania. They are meant for the new generation, as they meet both the societal and market requirements and the global trends while focusing mainly on the development of personal competencies of each individual. MA+ offers the opportunity to participate in research groups, work on international projects with scientists and apply your newly acquired knowledge. CONTINUE YOUR STUDIES AS A PHD



For those who have completed their master's studies and intend to choose the path of a researcher, KTU offers [doctoral studies](#) in the fields of technology, natural sciences, social sciences and humanities, in a total of 19 science fields. In nine of them, doctoral students have the opportunity to obtain a double doctoral degree with foreign research and study institutions.

Doctoral studies include studies, research, preparation and defence of a doctoral dissertation. Students receiving state-funded doctoral studies are paid monthly study support: 760 Eur / month in the first year of studies, 880 Eur / month in the second-fourth year of studies. Those who have successfully completed four years of doctoral studies and defended a doctoral dissertation are awarded a doctoral degree.

Doctoral studies at KTU provide employment opportunities in institutional, national and international research projects, international research internships at ECIU, EUA, BALTECH and other network universities, participation in international doctoral summer/winter schools, improvement of competencies in general skills development modules, development of your ideas into the prototypes in the Start-up space start-up community. Additional scholarships for the most active doctoral students, funding opportunities for studies, research and participation in scientific conferences open up excellent opportunities for young researchers.

The University’s culture is based on academic values and ethical principles. Academic integrity is one of KTU’s most important values.

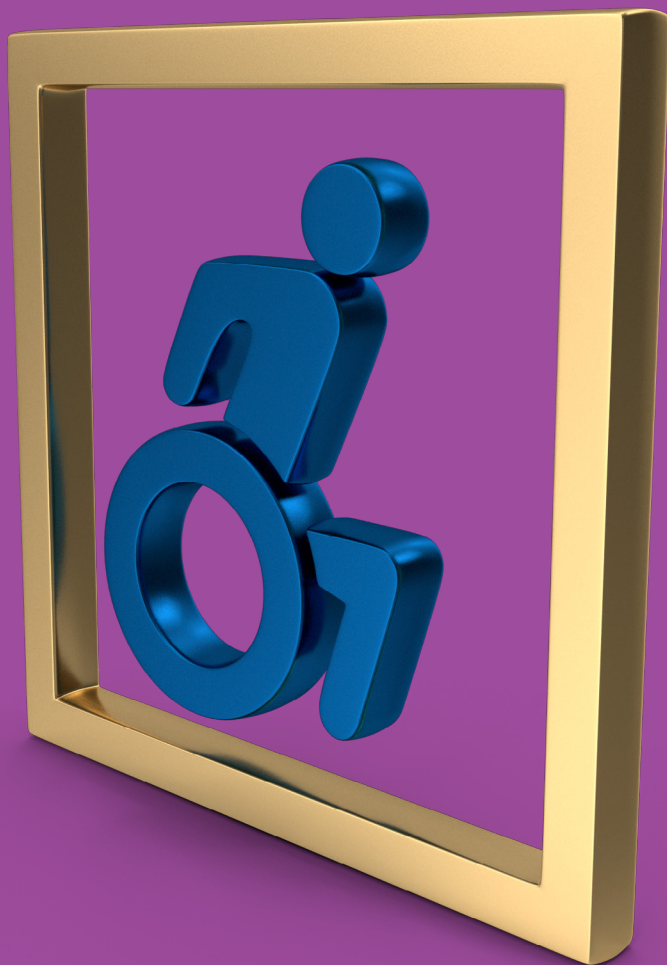

- Provide a document certifying individual needs (statement from a medical institution, psychologist's recommendation or certificate of the level of working capacity).

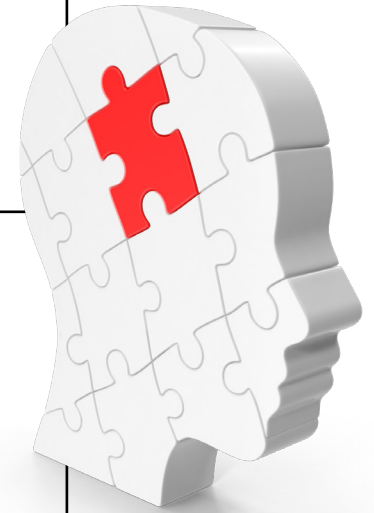

Marija provides individual psychologist counselling on the following topics: mood (increased depression, anxiety), self-esteem, stress management, communication, change of unhealthy habits and other difficulties, counselling in case of difficulties in studies, such as fear of assessments, attention difficulties, procrastination. Also, she conducts educational activities for the University's community. The psychologist is interested in the possibilities of preserving and strengthening mental health, dispelling the myths about mental health.

Fill in the [registration form](#) and we will agree on the time and date of the consultation. If you are unable to attend a psychologist's consultation at the agreed time, please inform us of the changes in the situation 3 working days in advance to agree on the next time, otherwise, you will have to re-register.

The duration of the consultation is 50 min. During an online consultation, the student must ensure a comfortable environment for the session: he or she must be alone, without other people or additional distractions.

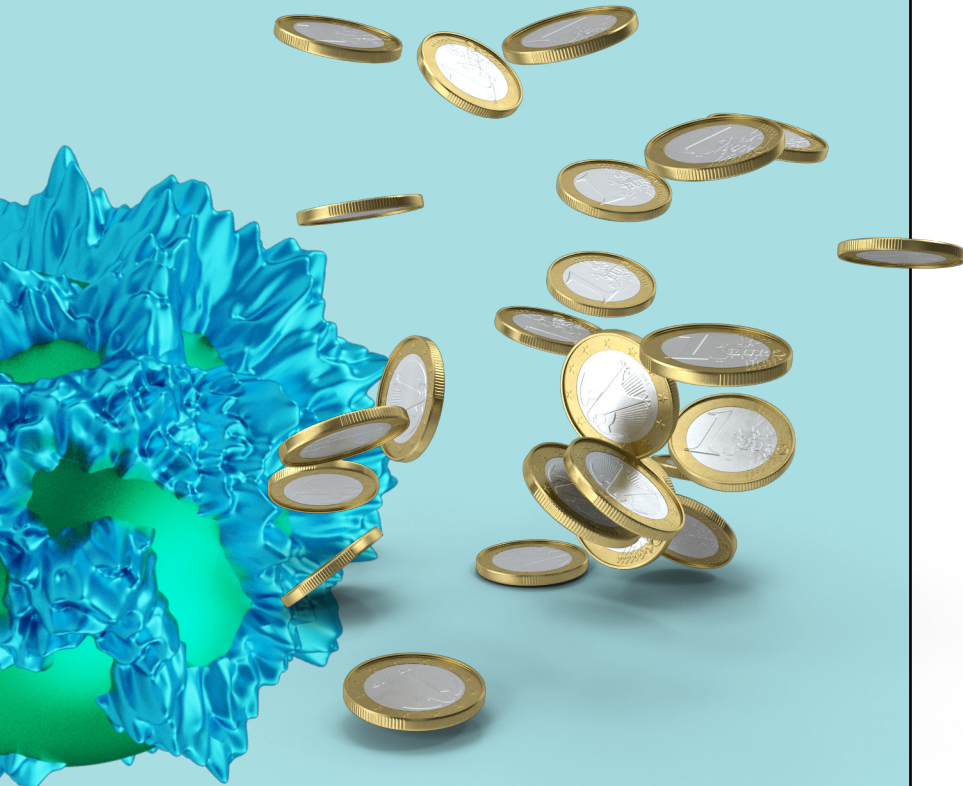

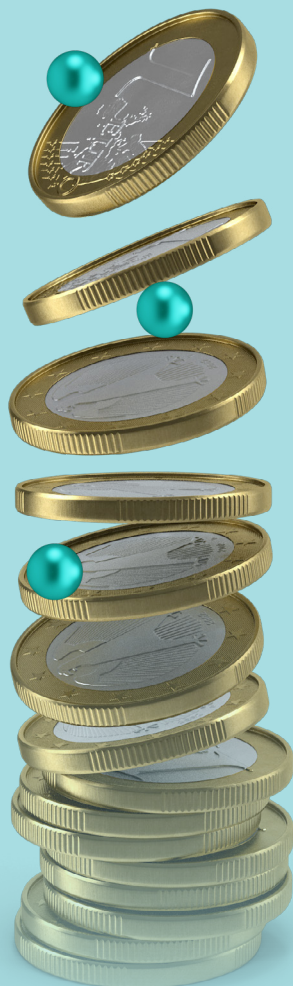

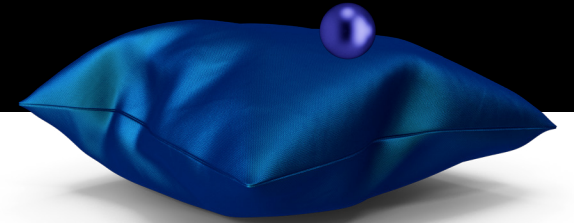
- Choose to live in a dormitory; you will save money, as well as make new friends and expand your social circle;
- If you choose to rent an apartment or house, do it with other students – you will reduce the cost of rent and be able to split the utility bills;
- Care not only for your wallet but also the environment – use public transport, the infrastructure will help you not to be late for lectures;
- Plan your expenses and track your cash balance regularly so you do not have to borrow money;
- Visit a KTU career planning consultant who will help you to make important decisions and get ready for the labour market;
- Sign up for free events;
- Take advantage of the discounts available to students and buy what you want at a lower price;
- Join the teams of the University's Sports Club or the Sports and Wellness Centre and stay in good physical shape free of charge.



DORMITORIES

KTU has [12 dormitories](#) located in or near the student campus.

Students are offered accommodation in triple, double and single rooms, which cost from 60 to 144 euros. The price depends on the type and condition of the dormitory and room (the price includes all utilities).

In each room, the resident will find furniture for individual use (a table, a bed, a chair, a closet) and internet access.

The dormitories have self-service laundries and dryers, lockable storage facilities for bicycles, parking lots located next to the dormitories.

The place in the dormitory can be reserved in the [Dormitory Reservation System](#), in the section RESERVATION or by logging onto KTU [AIS](#).

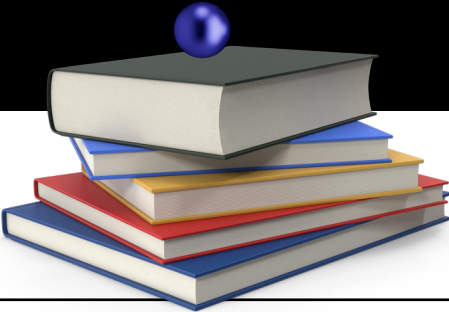

LIBRARY



As a student, you became a library reader immediately upon your admission to the University. You can use the services of the Library with a valid international student identity card, a personal identity card or a passport.



You can get all the information about resources and services by visiting the Library or the [website](#). Here, you can use the [Library's catalogue](#), KTU virtual library, resources of the Lithuanian Academic Electronic Library [eLABa](#), the databases of electronic sources.

In the Library, you can read and borrow printed publications, copy and scan excerpts from them.

The University's single sign-on system provides access to all subscribed and freely available information resources from any workplace at the University or home 24/7.

The central and faculty libraries have individual workplaces and group work rooms, computer and specialised workplaces for students with individual needs, and recreation areas. The group work rooms can be booked at the [link](#). You can chat with colleagues or enjoy a cup of tea in the lounges.

Every month, the Library organises training on how to find the information sources for written works, correctly quote the sources and prepare bibliographies, etc. The descriptions and schedules of the training are available at this [link](#). You can find the Library's teaching materials in Lithuanian and English in the virtual environment [Moodle](#).

A "Resources by Theme" [catalogue](#) has been composed and is constantly updated with links to freely available and subscribed databases, e-journals and books, final projects, and other information required for studies and research.

Each study and research field is supervised by a librarian who cooperates with the academic community of the faculty, consults on information retrieval and resource use issues, organises and conducts information literacy training, provides study modules with the latest study literature and electronic information sources.

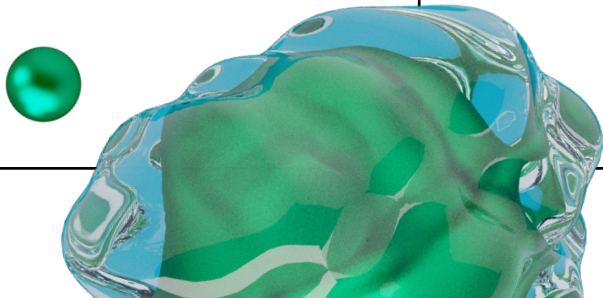

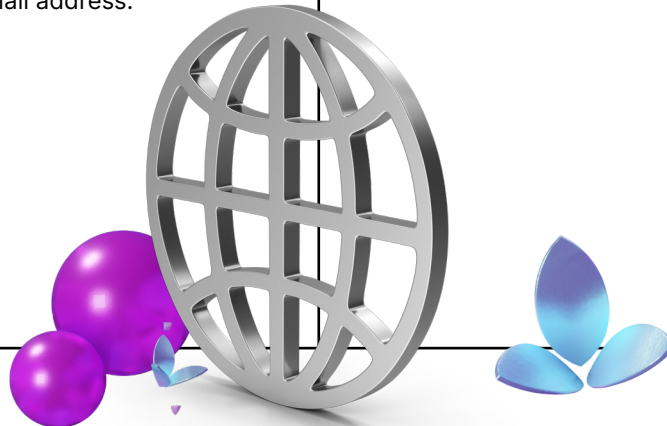

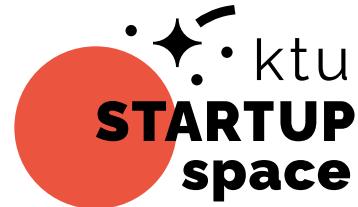
DesignLibrary Kaunas

ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME

It is the most popular student exchange programme in Europe. It provides an opportunity to learn and gain practical experience, creates an area of openness and tolerance, and promotes intercultural dialogue and global thinking.

The programme gives each student the opportunity to study and/or do an internship abroad in one study cycle for up to 12 months. A scholarship of 450-700 euros/month will help to survive in a new country. It depends on the activity and the country you are going to.

Studies
