ERASMUS+ Student Exchange



Students may carry out either one or a combination of the activities described below:

- ☐ Study period abroad at a partner higher education institution (HEI).
- ☐ Combination of studies and traineeship: either one activity after the other or both at the same time.
- □ Traineeship (work placement) abroad in an enterprise or any other relevant workplace. This includes Digital Opportunity Traineeships for students and recent graduates to develop or acquire digital skills.

Mobility for Studies



- KTU must have inter-institutional agreements with the receiving partner universities before the mobility for studies takes place;
- Following <u>courses</u> at a partner institution of a higher education;
- Recognition of learning outcomes/credits;

Mobility for Traineeships



- Students find a traineeship place by themselves.
- Traineeships can be completed:
 - during summer holidays;
 - during the mandatory traineeship/thesis semester;
 - within 12 months after graduation (recent graduate's traineeship).

Advantages of Exchange



- ERASMUS+ studies and/or traineeship is a fully recognised part of your diploma/degree.
- Studies at KTU are not terminated.
- Financial support is available.
- Scholarships/ payments from KTU remain.
- No age limit.
- ERASMUS+ is open to students with fewer opportunities (additional support is available).

Duration of the Exchange Activities



The same student may participate in **physical** mobility periods **up to 12 months maximum per each cycle of study**, independently of the number and type of mobility activities.



Mobility within NORDTEK network


- Countries: Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Iceland, Latvia, Norway, Sweden.
