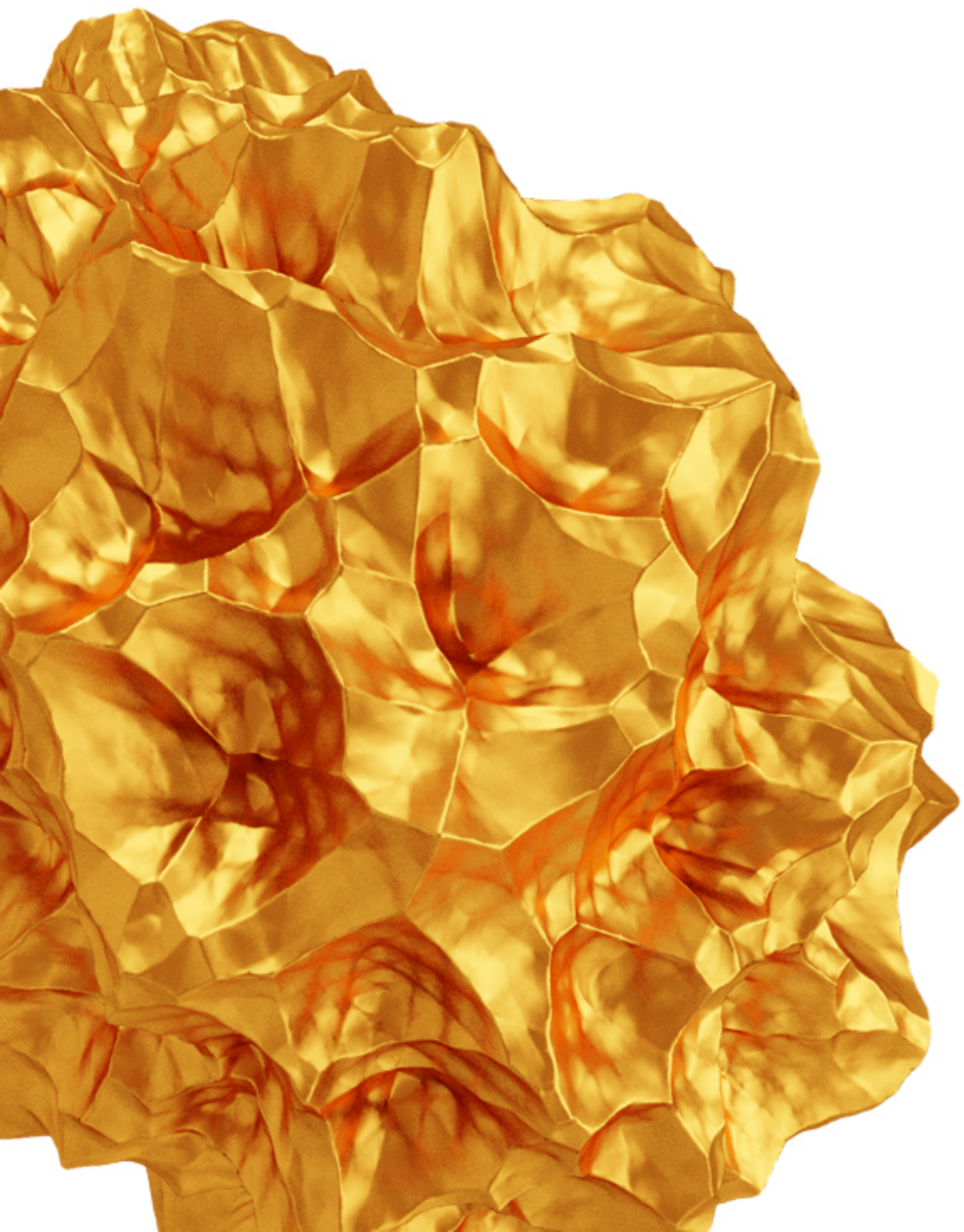
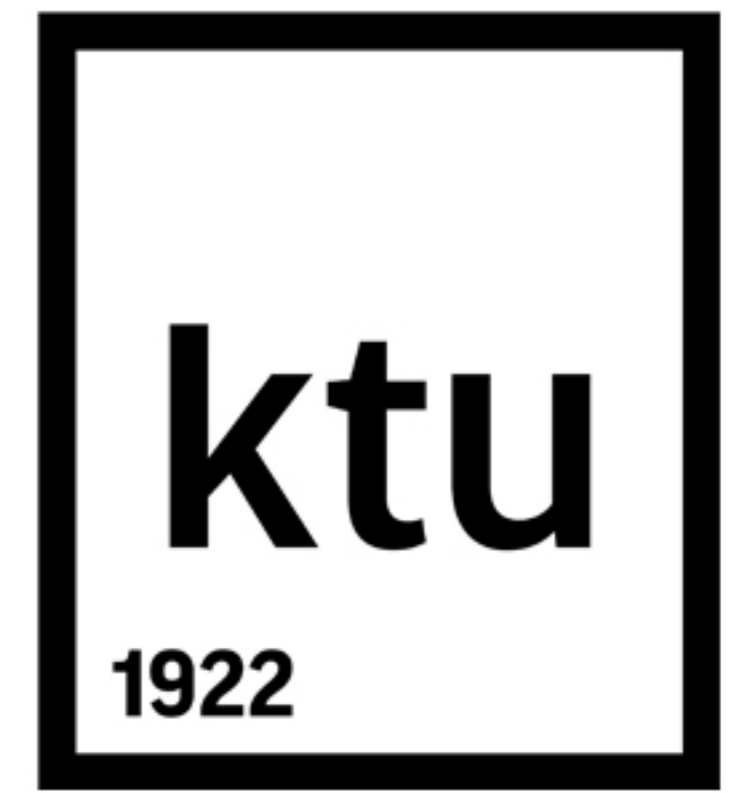

A student can be nominated to come to KTU:

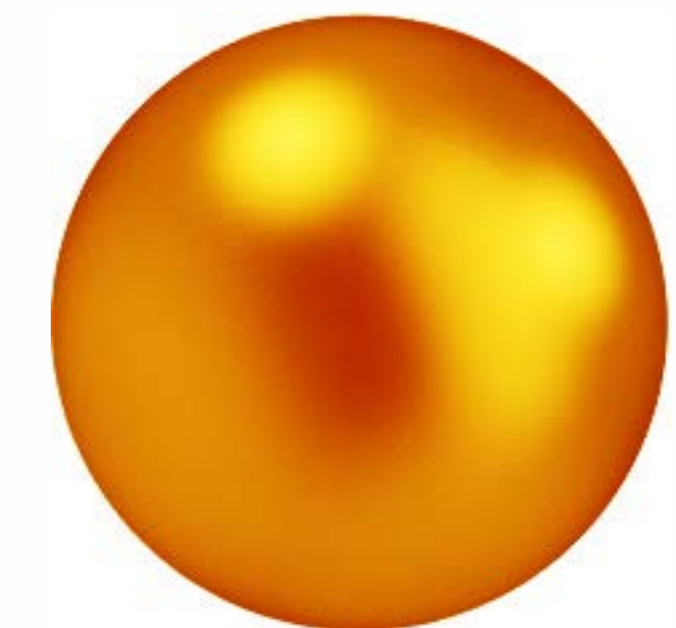
- when valid bilateral agreement between home university and KTU exists;
- under academic exchange programmes between countries.

Nomination should be done online.

Nomination timeline

- autumn semester
January 1st - June 1st
- spring semester
June 1st - November 1st

After the nomination, a unique link is sent to a student to start application procedure.



Application timeline

- autumn semester
April 1st - June 30th
- spring semester
September 1st - November 30th

Learning agreement:

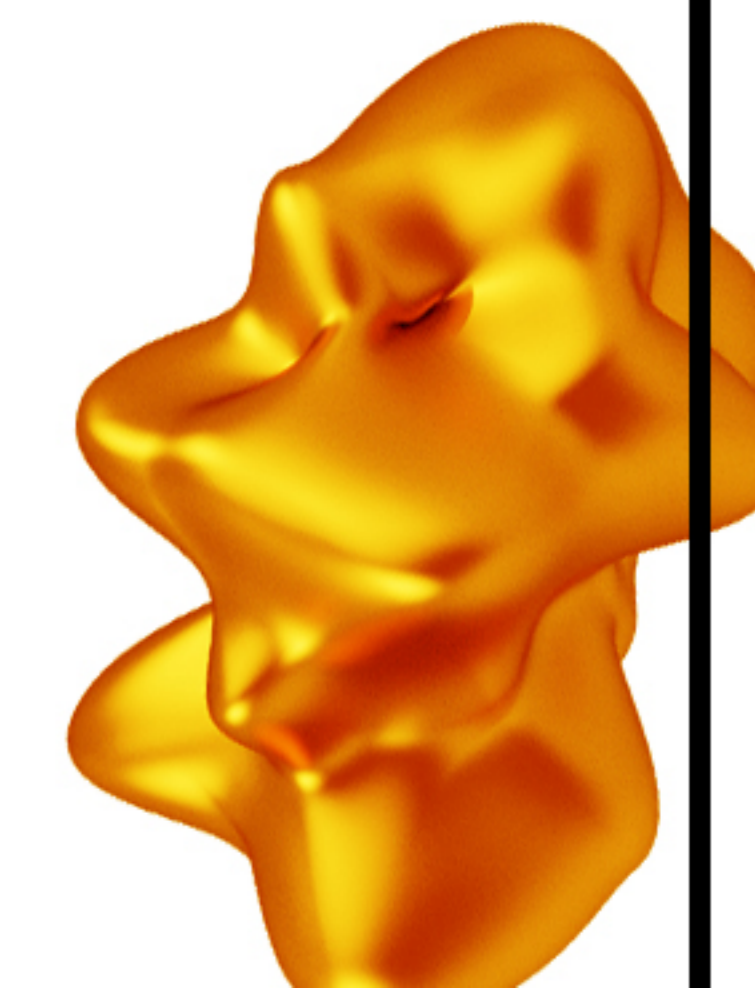
- *Online learning agreement for Erasmus+ exchange;*
- *Learning agreement for other exchange programmes.*

Transcript of records:

- *English language proficiency certificate
(CEFR B2+, IELTS 5.5+, TOEFL IBT 70+ or equivalent).*

Copy of valid passport (for non EU citizens or ID card
(only for EU and EEA citizens).

Students are only allowed to write their final thesis
if they have already found a supervisor at KTU on their own.

Exchange students are usually provided with a place in KTU dormitory.

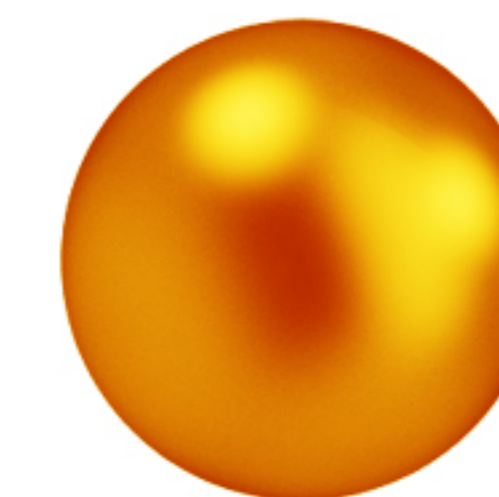

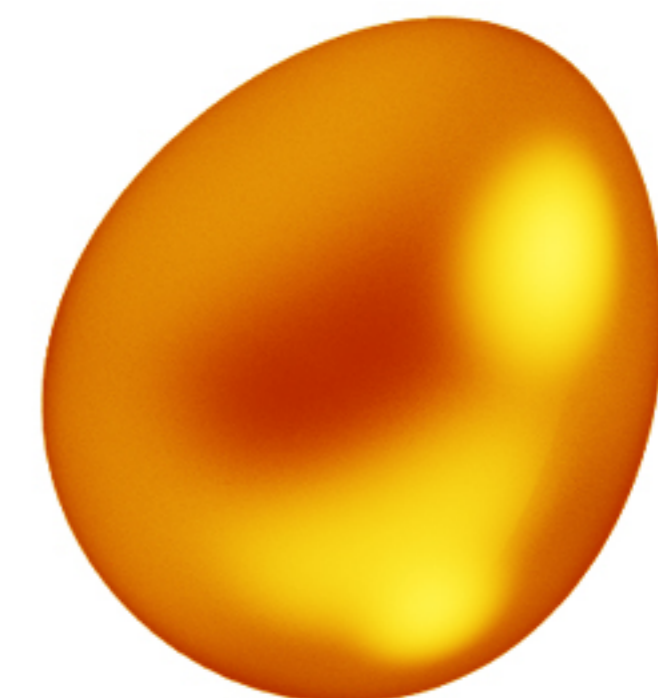
