Kaunas University of Technology for its students offers 12 dormitories located in KTU campus.

- International students live in dormitories No. 2, No. 3, No. 5, No. 7, No. 8, No. 10.
- To students we offer two types of rooms:
 - Single (rooms average area of 11-12 m²);
 - Double (rooms average area of 15-17 m²).



Procedure for guest visits

The guests can visit the dormitory from 8:00 to 00:00. The guests are registered in the guest book and receive their guest permit which they have to give back when leaving the dormitory. Dormitory residents of 2, 3 and 10 have to register a guest in the electronic journal.

At the resident's request and with the consent of the dormitory manager/administrator and other resident(s) of the room, the resident can have a guest stay overnight for five nights per month at most (two nights per month free of charge in total).

The requests regarding the overnight stay of the guests are submitted and approved in the Academic Information System (AIS).

The residents can use:

- working/studying and bicycle storage premises 24/7;
- rest and recreational premises from 8:00 to 00:00;
- sports facilities and sports grounds near the dormitory from 8:00 to 00:00;
- self-service laundry rooms from 7:00 to 21:00; laundry rooms in the basement from 7:00 to 00:00.

The resident, who is using the inventory in the working, recreational, sports premises and sports grounds, is fully responsible for his/her safety.

Filling of the applications/requests related to the living at the dormitory

The residents can fill in the following applications in the section Dormitory Information (click Requests) of the Academic Information System (AIS):

- application to use the parking lot with a permit;
- application to issue a new dormitory permit;
- application to order documents;
- application to use personal inventory;
- application to perform the repair works or replacement of the dormitory's premises or equipment using personal funds;
- notification on leaving the dormitory for the period up to one month;
- request to provide bedding service;
- request to provide cleaning service;
- request to keep small pets;
- registration for Short-Term Guest in the Dormitory;
- request for using the advance payment (deposit) to cover the unpaid fees for accommodation at the dormitory;
- application to move out.

- If possible, a resident can relocate by reserving another place at the Dormitory Reservation System.
- You can choose a preferred place for relocation in the reservation system according to the dormitory number, the type of the room (single, double) and the price range.
- The offers are formulated for changes in the reservation system from **the 21st to the last day of the current month** (inclusive).





Dormitory accommodation fee shall be paid before 25th day of current month.

How to find a payment information?

Login to KTU Academic Information System → Outstanding payments → All type of payment

Residence fee can be paid:

- By cash in Perlas terminal;
- Online from your bank account;
- By bank card using direct link on your AIS.

- KTU students, who have difficult material or social situation and do not pay more than 138 Eur for a room can apply for a dormitory accommodation grant;
- Applied monthly Accommodation Grant for one person at the dormitory is determined by the commission;
- **Scanned documents have to be submitted in your AIS by the 20th of each month at the latest.**

Dormitory is students community home where everyone should follow internal rules and respect each other.

Internal Dormitory Rules:

- Do not use tobacco products and electronic cigarettes;
- Do not keep, consume, produce and distribute alcoholic beverages;
- Produce dormitory pass to the receptionist;
- Do not noise from 10.00 p.m. to 7.00;
- Pay the dormitory fee in time;
- Do not harass dormitory employees or residence;
- Deny entry for unregistered guests;
- Do not move to a different room at one's own discretion;
- Do not relocate inventory without permission;
- Keep your room and other areas of the dormitory clean;
- Follow other rules of the dormitory;
- Keep the requirements of fire safety.

What to do if..?

- Something is broken or not working properly;
- I have a problem with the internet;
- How to use self-service laundry;
- I need to change my beddings;
- Need to absence from the dormitory for a longer period.
